Needing Space and Privacy to Serve Our Students

The last two Knightly News articles were written about the importance of additional classroom space and a middle school wing as part of the building needs. This month, we will share the need for more rooms to serve our students with the additional services we provide.

Many people might think that a typical school day for all of our students is spent in their classrooms. They may leave for music or PE class or go out for recess and then they always return back to their classrooms. For some students this is true, however, for many of our students they receive additional services to help us better meet their needs. It is important that students have proper privacy when the services are provided and the appropriate environment to be able to learn. One example of this need for proper space becoming an issue occurs with our speech pathologist. The speech pathologist, Mrs. Rosenboom, works with 10 students each week. She works with students who have an IEP (Individual Education Plan) to help them sound letters and words proficiently. Mrs. Rosenboom teaches these students in the library because her previous space is no longer available. Working in the library does not allow for proper privacy and uninterrupted learning. It also impedes other students from using the library when she is working with the students. Mrs. Raman, our enrichment teacher, teaches 3 classes a day in the faculty workroom. These classes are being interrupted with numerous daily occurrences because the copy machine, paper supplies, art supplies and the employee mailboxes are all located in the faculty workroom. We appreciate the many volunteers and paraprofessionals who assist our students in so many ways. However, you will often find them working with students in the hallways because the extra spaces are being used. These are just a few examples of the way HCS has run out of space and private rooms. These issues make it more challenging to meet our students' needs.








