This year we are celebrating milestones achieved by three employees. Mr. Hartbecke has been with HCS for 25 years, Teresa Fedders has been with us for 10 years and Mrs. Vermeer made the 5 year mark. Each of these individuals wore a variety of hats during their tenure at HCS.

Taking a walk down "Memory Lane" brings us back to 1999 when Mr. Hartbecke started as a part-time custodian and part-time resource room teacher.
