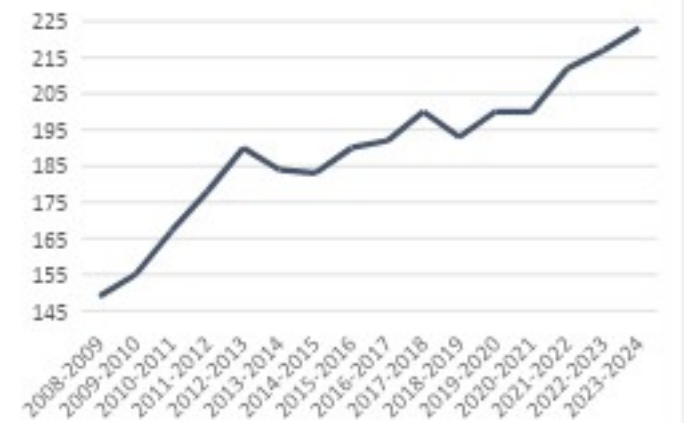
**Building Project Needs**

The next five issues of the Knighly News, will feature one area of need that will be met in phase one of our building project. This includes additional classrooms, a designated middle school area, workspace for outside services that our students need, an office location with a single point of entry and space for after school programs.

Additional classroom space is part of the blessing that comes because of the increased enrollment and that is what this Knighly News issue focuses on. HCS currently has two grades that are separated all day and two grades that are separated only in the morning. This has caused our Discovery Lab (science lab/art room) to be used as a full-time classroom. This is not an ideal set up for a classroom, and it is hard for teachers who need lab areas for science or easy-to-clean areas for art projects. We also have two elementary classes that are meeting downstairs. One of those classrooms shares the room with the orchestra students. A goal of the previous building project was to designate these rooms for after school programs and as a multi-purpose meeting space. However, those two rooms had to be repurposed into classrooms because of enrollment growth (see chart for details). The building project will be adding on seven new classrooms both to the east and northeast of the current building. This will meet the current and future needs of HCS as enrollment continues to rise and students' needs change. These classrooms will also be larger than most of the classrooms in school. This will allow teachers to set up their classrooms to better meet the needs of the students.
